





Every course/paper offered in the University shall have a unique Course Code consisting of 09 (nine) alphanumeric characters in the form of "XYZ-AB-101C" where the double alphabet characters "XYZ" shall identify the Introductory discipline to which the Course/paper belongs, AB identify the major/minor subject whereas the numeric characters specify the paper and its qualification level and "C" is the alpha character specifying the nature of the Course/paper under that level.
