The University of Ladakh is all set to conduct its Student Union Elections for the academic year **2025–26**. It is hereby notified that the elections will be conducted in strict accordance with the procedure laid down under **Article 6.2.2** of the recommendations of the **Lyngdoh Committee**, as approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, and in line with the bylaws of the University of Ladakh. The entire process will be carried out in a fair, transparent, and participatory manner, ensuring that democratic values are upheld and carried forward.

Through this electoral process, the University intends to bring in capable and committed student representatives who can step forward to take up leadership roles and work towards the welfare and development of the student community. Accordingly, elections will be held to fill up the following positions of the Ladakh University Students' Union (LUSU), Leh Campus for the year **2025–26**:

- **President**
- **Vice President**
- **General Secretary**
- **Joint Secretary**
- **Treasurer**
- **Sports Secretary**
- **Media Secretary**
- **Cultural Secretary**

Provided That:

- The elections shall be conducted by secret ballot under the Parliamentary mode, following the Simple Majority Election System.
- The office-bearers shall be elected by and from the entire student community of the campus.
- It is further stipulated that the candidates contesting for the posts of President, Vice President, and General Secretary must be from the final year of their respective programmes.
- The post of **Vice President** shall be reserved for a **female candidate**.

All candidates are required to:

- Carefully go through the LUSU Code of Conduct before filing their nominations.
- Submit a manifesto (mandatory for candidates contesting for the post of President).
- Furnish an affidavit in the prescribed format.
- A non-refundable nomination fee of **₹300/=** shall be deposited at the time of submission of nomination papers.
- Upon completion of the counting process, all used and unused ballot papers, along with result sheets and other relevant documents, shall be handed over to the Election Officer by the Presiding Officers without delay.

Candidates are advised to:

- Adopt and follow eco-friendly practices during the election process.
- Refrain from using non-biodegradable materials.


