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### About the Course

Research provides us new domain of knowledge, new theories and laws, solution to a problem and open new areas of thought. Further, it has the potential to question and analyze the existing theories in accordance to the present circumstances. Hence it is pertinent for educational professionals and researchers to be acquainted with the process of research i.e. research methodology. It is worth mentioning that research is a systematic process and the knowledge of research methodology help to understand what to do in specific situation. Therefore, it is very much important for a researcher to know all the aspects and steps of research process in order to make it systematic to a greater degree and hence, to stop the question to the reliability and validity of his/her work. This Training Course on Research Methodology will make the young researcher familiar with the various aspects, tools and steps of conducting social science research. The participants will be introduced to various methods of doing research i.e. quantitative, qualitative as well as mixed method approach. Hands-on sessions will be conducted using Microsoft Excel, SPSS, GIS and NVIVO. The programme will emphasize on the variety of tools and techniques of research methods used in social science studies. Alongside, the project assessment techniques will be discussed. The present program on Research Methodology will help participants in realizing and analyzing their full potential to contribute and achieve the best result in their personal growth and growth of education Institutions.

### Objective of the Course

The objective of this course is to provide an overview of the quantitative & qualitative research methods, assist immersion in specific techniques, and engage the participants with the key debates in the area, including those that argue on the essential unity of the logic of inference across research methods—qualitative as well as quantitative. The workshop will also introduce the participants to the key texts in the area of thematic focus, and introduce them to the approach of qualitative as well as quantitative research methods, specific tools, and techniques of data organization and analysis.

### Course Coverage

Broadly, the course intends to deal with a variety of analytical research methods used in social sciences and allied studies, with particular emphasis on the implementation of these methods. In addition, the participants will also be introduced how to use the software like SPSS and NVIVO for data analysis. The details of the topics to be covered have been given below:

- Meaning, Objectives & Types of Research, Research Approaches, Problem identification and formulations of Research Question;
- Research Design, Selection of research topic, Review of Literature;
- Concept and history of fieldwork, Stages of fieldwork – selecting a research setting, gaining access.

- Quantitative and Qualitative Research Methods, Survey Method and Sampling, Basic Quantitative Analysis,
- Ethics in Social Science Research.
- Academic Writing, Papers for Journals, Preparation of Reports.
- Ethics in Academic Writing.
- Structure of Paper, Report and Book, Elements of writing, e-library training
- Research Proposal, writing a research proposal, field visit & data collection
- Analysis of data using SPSS and NVIVO software.

### Eligibility Criteria for Participants

All Faculty and registered Ph.D. Research Scholars in recognized Indian university/Research Institute from any branch of Social Sciences can apply for this Research Methodology Course.

### Intake

The maximum intake for the Course shall be 30 seats (20 for out station and 10 for local). The selection will be made on first come first serve basis. Further, priority will be given to the participants belonging to Scheduled Tribe (ST) and the participants from the neighbouring states. Notification for selected candidates will be communicated through the registered email.

Interested candidates may apply to Course Director by filling up the application form on or before 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2024.
