Two days workshop on National Education Policy 2020 concluded at University of Ladakh, which was being organized by Department of Education, University of Ladakh, Leh Campus. The workshop started with the inaugural session presided over by Dean Academic Affairs, Dr. Sonam Jolden, giving inaugural address; he put detailed light on the main features of NEP 2020.

The workshop began with the warm welcome of the resource persons Prof. J. N. Baliya (Department of Educational Studies, Central University of Jammu) and Dr. Seema thappa (Department of Teacher Education, Nagaland University, Kohima) with the traditional Khatakas and Mementos. The welcome speech was given by Prof. Deskyong Namgyal, Controller Examination, University of Ladakh who welcomed the eminent professors and extended his sincere gratitude to each one for taking time out of their busy schedule to participate in this programme of engagement with the students and faculty members.
