Students may contact their respective colleges for Counseling if needed. The portal for online fee payment will be opened only after the certificates are verified.

NEP2020 has been introduced in all the colleges; therefore, counselling in colleges will be available for any assistance or advice about the choice of courses, as there will be no distinction between streams like Arts, Science, and Commerce. Please feel free to contact your nearest college on any working day.

Students with a one-subject compartment case should consult their respective colleges for more information.

### Eligibility:

- 1. Twelfth class pass or equivalent, from any recognized Board.
- 2. Students opting for Mathematics as a Major subject should have Mathematics in Higher Secondary
- 3. Students opting for science as a Major should have Science or allied subjects in Higher Secondary.
- 4. Students opting for Physics and Chemistry as a major should have Physics or Chemistry, or allied subjects, in Higher Secondary.
- 5. Choice of Generic (ID) courses should be different from Core (Major) and Minor courses.
- 6. The NCC course will be available only as a Minor subject.
- 7. Full-time BCA Course in NIELIT, Leh will give preference to students with science in their qualifying exam.

# Certificates to be attached during physical verification in colleges:

- 1. Matric certificate (Two self-attested copies)
- 2. Twelfth-class certificate (Two self-attested copies)
- 3. Provisional/Transfer Certificate (One Self-attested copy along with the original)
- 4. Migration Certificate (One Self-attested copy along with the original)
- 5. Character Certificate (One Self-attested copy along with the original)
- 6. Affidavit for Gap-Year candidates
- 7. Any other certificates as may be desired by the respective colleges.

#### Note:

- 1. Each college will reserve not more than 10% of the intake capacity for candidates outside their catchment area.
- 2. Each section will have multiple of 80 and 120 students for Practical and Non-practical subjects, respectively, depending upon the human resources and infrastructural facilities of the college.
- 3. Allotment of college admission and choice of courses will be based on merit, to be determined based on the Marks obtained by a candidate in the Qualifying Examination.
- 4. Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fee:
  - a. Deduction of Rs. 550 within the admission period without a late fee.
  - b. Deduction of Rs. 1100 after the last date of Admission
  - c. No claim of refund will be entertained after preparation of the RR.
- Each student should have a functional email address and mobile number for correspondence. Students should also remember their login ID and Password for further online correspondence.
