Professor Ibne Kanwal, one of the prominent writer of Urdu, is not only a fiction writer but also a sketch writer, essayist, travelogue writer, dramatist, critic, researcher and poet at the same time. He was born on October 15, 1957 Bahjoi Distt. Moradabad. His father was a national fame patriotic poet Qazi Shamsul Hasan 'Kanwal Dabaivi'. His native place is Dibai Distt. Bulandshahr. The original name of Prof. Ibne Kanwal is Nasir Mamood Kamal. Prof. Kanwal received his primary education at an Urdu medium Islamic school in Gunnaur Distt. Badaun. In 1967, he got admission in Minto Circle, one of the most famous schools under Aligarh Muslim University. After completing M.A. from Aligarh Muslim University in 1978, he came to Delhi University and obtained degrees of M.Phil. and Ph.D. in 1979 and 1984 respectively. In 1985, he joined the Department of Urdu, where his works & dedication towards his profession & Urdu literature got acknowledgement with promotion to the post of Reader in 1998, Professor in 2006 and Senior Professor in 2018. He has been the Head of the Department of Urdu, Delhi University twice, and after serving a long time Prof. Ibne Kanwal was retired on 31 October 2022.

Prof. Ibne Kanwal's first collection of short stories titled "Teesri Duniya Ke Log" was published in 1984, followed by "Band Raaste" in 2000 and "Pachas Afsaane" in 2014. In 2020, a collection of his sketches "Kuch Shaguftagi Kuch Sanjeedgi" as well a collection of plays "Bazm-e-Dagh" were published while a collection of essays (Inshayee) "Basat-e- Nishat-e-Dil" and a collection of travelogues "Chaar Khoont" were published in 2021 and 2022 respectively. He had written several books in fiction and non-fiction prose too. "Bostan-e-Khyal Hindustani Tahzeeb ke Tanaazur mein", "Dastan Se Novel tak", "Dastan ki Jamaliyat", "Tanqeed-o-Tahseen", "Mir Amman", "Nazir Akbarabadi ki Shayari", "Urdu Afsana", "Urdu Shayari", "Tanqeedi Izhar" and "Pahle Aap" (play) are among other important books of Professor Ibn-e-Kanwal. He has also compiled about a dozen books with his long prefaces. His two collections of short stories have been published in Arabic under the titles "Ahlul-Kahf" and "Al-Hulm" which were translated in Arabic by Professor Ahmed Al-Qazi of Al-Azhar University, Cairo, Egypt. While his short stories have been translated in Russian and published from Moscow too. The State Urdu Academies of Delhi, Haryana, UP, Bihar, and West Bengal have honoured him with their respectful awards. The Delhi Urdu Academy Fiction Award, The Haryana Urdu Academy Kunwar Mahindra Singh Bedi Sahar Award, The West Bengal Urdu Academy Abdul Gafoor Nassakh Award and The Sir Syed Milinium Award for Urdu fiction are among those he received for his contribution to the Urdu literature. He has participated in international seminars in America, Mauritius, England, Pakistan, Russia, and Uzbekistan. He has presented papers and delivered keynote speeches at several national and international seminars and conferences.
